The Quasem Foundation is committed to the advancement of education and the creation of opportunities for students to flourish. The foundation endeavors to significantly influence the lives of students, particularly those from underprivileged and gifted backgrounds, through a variety of initiatives, such as the establishment of primary school and scholarship programs.



NNZ-QUASEM SCHOOL

In 2022, the Quasem Foundation, in collaboration with the Netherlands-based company NNZ, established an English version school in Ulipur, Kurigram. The NNZ-Quasem School spans a 66-decimal land area and features a two-story building with a large playground. The school offers primary education designed to provide a strong foundation in reading, writing, and mathematics, along with an elementary understanding of other subjects.

The instruction is delivered in both English and Bangla, following the Bangladeshi national curriculum. The school includes a kindergarten level and classes from 1 to 5, ensuring a solid foundation for behavioral and learning etiquette. The long-term vision for the NNZ-Quasem School is to gradually expand its facilities to offer education up to Class 12, providing comprehensive educational opportunities for the students of Ulipur and surrounding areas.





Male-Female Student Ratio




Male-Female Teacher Ratio

NNZ-QUASEM SCHOOL TEACHERS' PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

The teachers of NNZ-Quasem School actively participate in the Alokito Teachers Workshop, a comprehensive three-day program that takes place twice a year. This workshop centres on the core principles of pedagogy, encompassing early childhood development, cognitive processes of learning, and efficacious techniques for incorporating brain breaks. The objective is to improve instructional differentiation and scaffolding techniques in order to assist a wide range of learners. Alokito Teachers (AT) is an online platform that focusses on providing individualised, research-supported professional development for educators in grades K-12. The platform provides a variety of courses that cover topics such as inquiry-based learning, game-based learning, problem-based learning, student psychological development, 21^{st} century classroom strategies, and classroom management. These courses aim to empower teachers to become compassionate leaders and lifelong learners.
